Proposed Budget (presented by the Board)

From the proposed budget income and charitable donations documentation provided in advance of the meeting or as a handout, the Board went through all items line-by-line and addressed any questions, concerns or suggestions

The following clarifications and comments were made:

- OCIA gifts - Cathy B has an action item to check with Dawn and Karen Lowe regarding what has been done in the past for candidates that are received
- Funeral reception expenses are kept under separate accounting
- R2R cash box startups will be increased by \$100 to cover an additional cash box need (5)
- Catholic Fund for Human Trafficking should be changed to Alliance to End Human Trafficking to more accurately reflect the organization's purpose
- College/Trade School supplies amount will need advertisement so it can be taken advantage of
- Cornerstone Road Kits is the LOT (Least of Those) project that produces kits for public safety organizations to give out to un-sheltered individuals
- Heart Locker is an initiative to combat homelessness in School District 5 through Elrod Elementary
- Marie Whalen remembers from her time on the CCW Board that the \$5k CD was originally placed for St Mathews scholarships
- Julie Moffitt suggested anyone wanting to request fund allocations to do so during the summer when the (new) CCW Board is meeting in preparation for the Fall allocations and to create a form to do so
- Deb Marrinan suggested a discretionary fund be created for emergency and unknown items
- Sue Bradley suggested we could better describe and advertise the value CCW provides to the Parish and community by including in-kind and non- monetary donations, such as volunteer hours and food donations in our CCW impact communications
